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

Re-orient TDA/SAP process: Problems & opportunities







GEF 7 INTERNATIONAL WATERS

- Ocean ecosystems under anthropogenic pressure from climate change, acidification, habitat loss, pollution, fishing, shipping and seabed mining
- A number of valuable coastal ecosystems and open oceans lack sustainable governance structures resulting in continued degradation
- Need for multi-national cooperation supported by regional organizations to address multifaceted threats to transboundary marine ecosystems
- Regional organizations need to function as hubs for harnessing, coordinating and channeling political and economic interest from public and private sectors

GEF 7 INTERNATIONAL WATERS Objective 1

- Blue Economy opportunities in countries will be strengthened through three areas of strategic action under GEF 7 addressing key stressors:
 - Sustaining healthy coastal and marine ecosystems
 - Catalyzing sustainable fisheries management
 - Addressing pollution reduction in marine environments

Expectations of Regional Projects

- Regional projects will need to leverage substantial co-financing, e.g. through blended financing
- Regional projects need to be aligned with endorsed Strategic Action Programmes (SAPs)
- Gender issues, gender considerations will be mainstreamed into all processes and investments
- Knowledge Management



Possible Areas of Focus for New PIF

- Regional Governance Framework Operationalization of Coordination Mechanism
- Activities to support C-SAP implementation

MSP

- Activities to support Regional Action Plan Implementation
- Activities to support Private Sector Investments (Implementation of Investment Plans)
- Development of New (integrated) SAP (existing SAP timeline ends 2025)
 - This includes finalizing SOMEE and supporting structures (institutionalization)
 - SOMEE as the institutionalized TDA. Threats & Opportunities
