(OSPESCA reaffirmed they had finalized their review and were OK with the text)

Types of Comments received

- Requests for <u>clarifications</u> ← PCU provided responses
- Requests for <u>modifications</u> (corrections/additions/deletion) to the text
- Some requested modifications were editorial, some seek to ensure consistency/remove ambiguity, some seek to clarify/remove inaccuracies in procedural matters, some identified omissions, some were considered by their proponent to constitute non-negotiable conditions for their participation in the CM



Types of Comments received

- Most (but not all) requested modifications came from the legal review by IGOs
- IGO's held a meeting on 5 Oct 21 and discussed and agreed on a set of proposed modifications to be presented at the PSCM: ACS (L), CARICOM, ECLAC (L), UNDP (L), UNEP (L), IOC-UNESCO, OSPESCA

(L) = Legal Experts participated in the call

 Proposed modifications emanating from the consultation process are included in <u>track changes</u> in the version of the MoU circulated prior to the meeting



Summary of Comments

A. TO BE DISCUSSED FIRST

- 1. The addition of <u>two new articles</u> have been proposed:
 - **NEW ARTICLE 32:** Privileges and Immunities of Signatories
 - ARTICLE 27: Funding of Cooperation & Collaboration (new text)
- 2. Additions of text to existing articles:
 - CM = no legal personality, CM = no legally binding rights nor obligations
- 3. Clarifications relative to the **powers** of the **Steering Group**, **Executive Group**
- 4. Request for MOU to be finalized in 3 languages: **English**, **Spanish** and **French** all versions **equally authentic**

B. TO FINALIZE THE TEXT

- 1. 2 **open issues** (punctual matters: signature custodianship, extraordinary meetings)
- 2. Suggestions for *added clarity* on a few *procedural matters/removal of inaccuracies*
- 3. Suggestions to *add definitions/harmonize use of concepts/abbreviations*, where missing, ambiguous or inconsistent
- 4. A few editorial suggestions



Reminder:

- Draft MoU text was technically endorsed at last PSC Meeting
- The comments received emanated from the Feb21 PSCM request/recommendation for a final (legal) review
- Very few remaining substantive comments, most suggestions are minor and likely to be easily resolved



PROPOSED WAY FORWARD (1)

All remaining proposals for change (available to PCU): in MOU in track changes/square brackets

PROPOSED WAY FORWARD (2)

- Track changes/square brackets will be removed once agreement/no objection is achieved (English and Spanish versions)
- Chair may decide to defer issues that cannot be readily resolved to Agenda Item 5 (MoU finalization)
- Full revised MOU text to be cleared (in English, and, if possible, Spanish) during Agenda Item 5.
- Further language reconciliation (English-Spanish-French) may need to take place after meeting
- MoU Finalization: @ the PSCM
- Opening for Signature: immediately following language reconciliation
